



## EVALUATION SYSTEM

(Std. I to V)

As per GSEB guidelines, Continuous Comprehensive Evaluation (CCE) system will be followed. For the overall development of students educational, social, intellectual and physical qualities will be observed throughout the year. On the basis of students participation in Co-Curricular activities their qualities like behaviour, liking, interests will be noted down by continuous observation. Thus it becomes compulsory for students to attend school regularly.

There will be two Semesters in one academic year.

At the end of each semester there will be Written Exam from Semester wise syllabus.

- Summative Assessment (SA) of 50 marks will be conducted at the end of each semester.
- Internal Assessment of 20 marks (Notebooks & Subject Enrichment) will be conducted on a regular basis.
