In School students are grouped into four houses named after each letter of A-M-B-E.

Head Boy and Head Girl are selected from Std. V who are responsible for the overall development and discipline of the school along with the house leaders.

Depending upon the personal aptitude and to inculcate the quality of leadership, group loyalty, personality, belongingness, co-ordination among peer group, we elect class representatives from each house. Two Class Representative from all sections are elected as discipline monitors. Students from Std. III onwards will have the opportunity to vote. Parents are requested to guide the children about the importance and procedure of Elections.

All the Selected / Elected members of students council will perform their duties allotted to them housewise.

Inter house competitions will be organised in sports and co-curricular activities according to **handbook planning** during **CA** periods. Points will be awarded to the students throughout the year. At the end of the year the house scoring the highest marks or points will be declared the best house for that academic year.

## SCHOOL LIBRARY

1. Students of Std. I to VII will be given a book to read every week in the school during Library period & Books will be issued only to the students of Std. VIII to XII.
2. Students of Std. VIII to XII can be issued one book at a time for a period of one week.
3. No books will be further issued unless pending items are returned.
4. Strict silence and discipline must be maintained in the library.
5. Reference books are not issued. These books can be consulted within the library premises only.
6. Books marked, disfigured or damaged will have to be replaced by the borrower or a payment of **50% in excess** of the cost price of the book is to be made.
7. If the issued book is lost by the student it is compulsory to submit the new edition book in the library.
8. Do not fold the pages of the books, use bookmarks.
9. Any student found damaging or defacing a book will be debarred from the library for the whole academic year.
10. Replace the books at their proper place after reading.
11. Fine of **Rs. 5/- per day** will be charged if the books are not returned on the due date.
12. Current month magazines will be issued after the display for a specific period.
13. Students are not allowed to bring their personal books or belongings to the library
14. We strongly advise parents to encourage their children to read books.
